MEDICINE POLICY & EMERGENCY INHALER:

The Link Academy has updated our policy for administering medicine. We will administer both prescribed and non-prescription medicines as long as all medicines are in their original container, with the pupil's names and dosage required. Parents will need to see Paula and complete our administering medicines form. Prior written parental consent is required before any medication can be administered.

We also have an emergency inhaler for use when a child's inhaler has been lost or is out of date, again, this can only be used if a parent has previously signed a consent form.

CHENOBYL CHILDREN'S LIFELINE, SOUTH HAMS LINK

Thanks to CCLL, some 60,000 children from Belarus have visited Britain since 1992. The children stay with host families and always receive basic medical attention here including dental care and an eye examination. The charity pays for the travel costs of the first visit, from then on the host family pays if they want the same child to return. No-one in the CCLL gets paid for their involvement - host families, doctors, dentists, opticians, fundraisers . . . everyone gives their time and energy for free. We have been asked by CCLL volunteer, Mrs Marion Adams (01803 862838) if we would consider collecting good quality second hand clothing for both summer and winter for children aged 8-10 years.(no shoes please). We thought this was a worthy cause to collect for and I hope you will too. We will have a collection bag in the entrance hall. I know that she is particularly looking for special items such as sparkly dresses for the girls ~ a real treat for these children.
