PROBLEMS ON THE ROAD

The owners of ANRAM have asked me to let you know that next Wednesday and Thursday there will be a convoy of buses bringing 450 people to an international LUSH event. They will be coming from Charlies Cross, past the farm shop and through Staverton between 8:30 & 9:30. This route to school may be best avoided unless you really like reversing! It's great that they have let us know in advance!

Mrs Jessep will attached a document from Devon County Council to let you know that there will be road closures between Parkfield Cross and Thorne Croft from:

MONDAY 25 JUNE 2018 for a maximum of 5 days until FRIDAY 29 JUNE 2018 and
MONDAY 2 JULY 2018 for a maximum of 5 days until FRIDAY 6 JULY 2018.
